



What is a Neighbourhood Plan?

A **Neighbourhood Plan** takes into consideration the needs of its locality and sets out how Aspire Housing will work collaboratively with local people, communities and local partners to **make positive change** in a people first manner.

The aim of the plan is to make best use of community assets, resources within the locality and coordinate partnership approaches to **invest** where it is needed most.

The Kidsgrove community has a strong community spirit and a distinct sense of place that we want to build, strengthen and be part of.

There are huge opportunities for the town and communities, enhanced by Town Deal funding and an established partnership of statutory, public, voluntary, charitable and community representation.

Due to its town centre and transport dynamics, greater Kidsgrove is a focal point for investment incorporating Talke, Talke Pits, Newchapel, Mow Cop and the surrounding areas. There is a high proportion of natural commute through Kidsgrove and lots of people utilising amenities for work and pleasure.

- Improve health and wellbeing for the communities of Kidsgrove by supporting Kidsgrove Sports Centre and a diversionary programme locally for younger people
