Through conversations with partners, local stakeholders and Aspire colleagues, feedback from Aspire tenants and insight gained through the customer-focused Chat 2 Aspire Neighbourhood Survey we have created 'Your Neighbourhood Plan'.

This plan will help to address the challenges within the town centre area and through working together in partnership create homes, premises and places we can all take pride in whilst improving quality of life and life chances for its residents.

All areas have challenges, some are unique to that area whilst others are more generic across all communities within the Newcastle-under-Lyme borough.

### What you told us...

Through Chat 2 Aspire we asked you to share your thoughts about your area, you told us that you are proud of your community, there is a 'community spirit' and the town centre is great and local green spaces.

Aspire could help to make positive changes by tackling nuisance behaviour, considering who we are letting our homes to, improving outdoor spaces and parking. You also told us you would like our teams and partners to be more visible in our communities, and some of you would like to be more involved in your local community.

There will be lots of opportunities to continue to engage with us through the work we will be doing in your area.

# in your Neighbourhood

**Aspire Housing** owns and manages around **500 homes** and commercial premises within Newcastle-under-Lyme town centre. The Town Centre forms part of Aspire Housing's South Neighbourhood Management area.

We know our town centre has seen decline in recent years, resulting in businesses closing and commercial units left empty. We want this to change. We want our home town to thrive again and offer ways of improving levels of unemployment and nuisance behaviour to help our communities grow stronger and healthier.

In the coming years the town centre area is one that will undergo significant transformation, having been successful in acquiring significant investment through the Town Deal regeneration funding. There is a growing student market in and around the town centre which will generate further income and investment. Aspire Housing has also made a significant commitment to the area through the development of new homes at the Holborn Place, Zanzibar and Ryecroft sites.

These exciting new developments, along with successful collaborations between Aspire Housing, local residents and partners, will create a vibrant place to live, work and visit.

### Local Strengths

### Local Challenges

- High levels of anti-social behaviour/ fear of crime including impact of rough sleepers/sitters loitering in and around the town
- High levels of vulnerability within the community due to drugs and substance misuse and poor mental health

# For People



We will be visible within our communities, helping customers to access support services when needed. We will support and empower our customers to access training and employment opportunities to increase skills and confidence and help communities realise their potential.

#### Our Promise...

- Engage, listen and work with customers to address issues in their area
- Support tenancy sustainment to help customers remain in their homes and encourage community cohesion
- Work in collaboration with partners through The WorkShop and other initiatives to improve opportunities for local people to access training and employment opportunities and develop/build on skills
- Work with Achieve Training to provide apprenticeship opportunities to young people in Newcastle
- Support Customers who are struggling financially through our Money Advice service and signposting to partner agencies

- Raise awareness of fuel poverty and options available to customers to access advice and support
- Support customers to access digital workshops to help build skills and confidence in using digital platforms to access services
- Support Newcastle-under-Lyme Borough Council to provide temporary accommodation to households at risk of homelessness
- Work in partnership with Newcastle-under-Lyme Borough Council and other partners to offer support and rehousing opportunities to people to tackle 'rough sleeping' around the town.



We will improve the quality of life in our communities and help customers feel safe by working with our partners to tackle nuisance behaviour which impacts on our communities.

- Provide well maintained neighbourhoods
- Carry out regular 'estate walkabouts' to check on our local areas and tackle issues
- Make sure our homes and schemes continue to be safe places to live
- Work with partners to regenerate sites that are impacting on neighbourhoods
- Work with Newcastle-under-Lyme Borough Council to improve recycling facilities for our customers living in our town centre flats
- Work with partners to tackle nuisance behaviour from rough sleepers loitering around our town centre schemes
- Improve security measures as a solution to nuisance behaviour

- A 'People First' approach to letting homes and supporting new tenants
- Promote the benefits of Community Living to older persons living in our communities
- We will engage with customers to consider ideas for environmental community projects to help improve external areas of our schemes
- Provide opportunities for residents to improve their health and well being
- Promote local events and community projects through our media channels to promote the benefits of town centre living
